

Using Cadence Allegro PSpice

Logging In

Find one of the PCs in TLG which is labeled: *Allegro*
(currently *w1718, w1883, w1886, w1891, w1894, w1901*)

Login using the username: *cdst1*

Scroll the Log on to box to: *Wxxxx*

(e.g. *W1894*)

Type in the password

Accessing Filestore

Go to: Start

Right click on My Computer

Choose: Map Network Drive

For University Filestore (M: Drive)

Choose Drive: *M:*

For Folder type in: *\\island.sms.ed.ac.uk\Home\matric number*
(e.g. *\\tiree.sms.ed.ac.uk\Home\s0568999*)

Untick: Reconnect at Login

Left Click: different username

For User name type in: *matric number@ed.ac.uk*
e.g. *S0568999@ed.ac.uk*

For Password type in: *your password*

For SEE Filestore

Choose Drive: *Z:*

For Folder type in: *\\labhomes.see.ed.ac.uk\matric number*
(e.g. *\\labhomes.see.ed.ac.uk\s0568999*)

Untick: Reconnect at Login

Left Click: different username

For User name type in: *matric number@ed.ac*
e.g. *S0568999@ed.ac.uk*

For Password type in: *your password*

You may map both filestores if you wish.

Running Allegro Pspice

Go to: Start -> All programs -> Allegro SPB 15.5 -> Design Entry CIS

Note an error message TLK0015 “*unable to open capture.INI*” will appear. This can be ignored, just click OK to continue.
